Education and Outreach Programme

Bengaluru, Nov 29th (Karnataka Information)

As part of Education and Outreach Programme Bengaluru Bannerghatta Biological Park (BBMP) has organized conservation talk by Dr. AJT Johnsingh on 1st December 2019 from 11.45 am to 12.45 pm in the Zoo Auditorium.

Dr. AJT Johnsingh is one of India's leading naturalists and field biologist. He carried out a study on Dholes (*Cuon alpinus*) in Bandipur Tiger Reserve in the late 1970s, which was a first such study on a free ranging large mammal in India. He served as a Dean of Faculty of Wildlife Sciences, from Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun for 20 years. He was awarded the Distinguished Service Award by the Society for Conservation Biology, the Carl Zeiss Wildlife Conservation Award, both in 2004, the ABN AMRO Sanctuary Lifetime Wildlife Service Award in 2005, 'Kirloskar Vasundhara Sanman' in 2014' and Salim Ali Conservation Award in 2015.

The talk focuses on "Conservation in India with special reference to Karnataka" We welcome people from all walks of life to attend this talk and normal entry fee applies.

Life science students can avail free entry for the event with a letter from their Principal for maximum of 20 students from each Institute.
